Volunteer Requirements and Additional Information

- **Camp location** | Northwood Middle School (945 North Ave, Highland Park, IL 60035)
- **Dates** | June 28th – July 29th, 2021 (Monday – Thursday)
- **Volunteer camp times** | 12:00-4:30pm
- **Volunteer age requirement** | Must be a current sophomore in high school or older
- **Time commitment for volunteers** | Volunteer participation is highly encouraged for the entire 5 weeks of the camp. A commitment of 2-4 days per week (minimum 2 weeks) is required in order to volunteer.
- **Required volunteer counselor trainings** | ALL volunteers are required to attend a training. Training dates: June 8th 5-7pm OR June 9th 10-12pm at Nuestro Center (501 Bank Lane, Highwood, IL 60040)
- **Other requirements** |
 - Interested counselors must fill out a summer volunteer application form available online at <https://forms.gle/YnGmc1UXfeufWy1a7>
 - **NEW** volunteers must obtain 2 recommendations forms from adults. (If you have volunteered for Nuestro Center's Homework Club or Summer Camp in the past, you do not need recommendation forms.)
 - If you are 18 years of age or older, please also complete and return the State of Illinois' Authorization for Background Check as well as DCFS's Mandated Reporter training. The training can be found and completed on their website; Upon completing the training, you will receive a PDF copy of your certificate which can be emailed to us.
